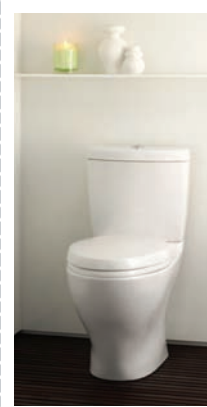

Letter From the President



It always amazes me how just as Labor Day arrives, the temperature suddenly drops a good 20 degrees or more overnight! After our brutally hot summer, I am happy for fall to arrive and give us a break from the heat.

This summer not only gave us record heat, but also a depletion of our water supply due to lack of rain. With years of unpredictable weather ahead, a certain decline in our water resources and an incline the cost of water, our family is doing all we can to conserve our water usage.

I started off the summer by just testing our irrigation system but leaving it off. Then as the heat rose and the lawn started to die, I decided to run it for a month. Our next water bill arrived and my wife screamed, "\$400 for one month!" So, we went back to just using the rain barrels for outdoor watering. The problem was that we seemed to get all our rain in one day, so our rain barrels would fill up, but then go dry long before our next rainfall. We realized that our rain barrels just weren't catching enough water and started researching options for a rainwater collection system.

With our water bills averaging 12% increases or more per year, this is an easy and logical decision. Fall is actually the perfect time to install a rainwater system, since it allows it settle over the winter and be ready for the spring rain. We spoke with Ecovie, a local rainwater system company and found
